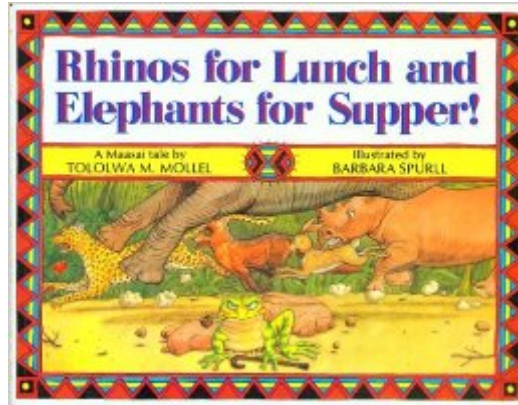

All during the story it is evident the children's imaginations are whirling wildly. A must have for any teacher or reading volunteer.
