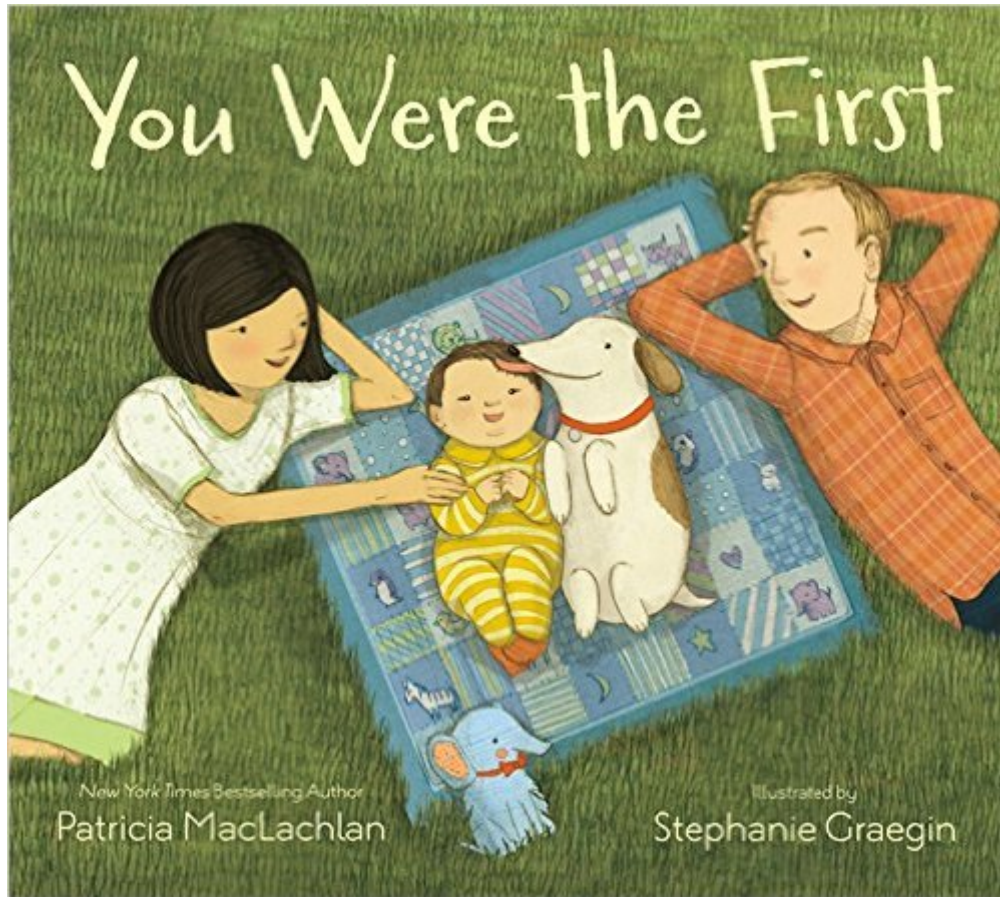

This is a cute book. Our kids are only 20 months apart so I got this to read to my oldest when his sister was born. Like other reviewers have mentioned, I think it's rather specific re: pets, grandparents, location like ocean or suburbs. We have cats, live in a condo in a city so it doesn't all match, but the idea is there and it reads nicely. Until my kid is old enough to know the difference, I

just change some of the words to fit our family a little bit better. Also, I think these books may be produced next to an onion factory, because no matter what, every time my son asks me to read this to him my eyes tear up. So weird. Someone should look into that.

I just got this book from the library and decided that I needed to add it to my home collection. The illustrations are beautiful and the text is easy to read and flows well together. At first my preschooler didn't want to read it since I'm the one who picked it out and not him but a couple pages in and he was all about it. We laughed and giggled about all his firsts and he even shared some memories with me. It was adorable. It was a gentle reminder of how special he is to mommy and daddy which he needs to hear even more now that we've added another baby to the family. This is a must no matter if you have just one little one at home or if you're adding #2 or more.

Our 3 year old daughter is getting ready for her new baby brother and this book is now our special book! Our dog Sharkee fits right in with the story line, so overall this is a great book. She understands that she is the first of many things and now she can show or watch the experiences with her new baby brother when he comes.
