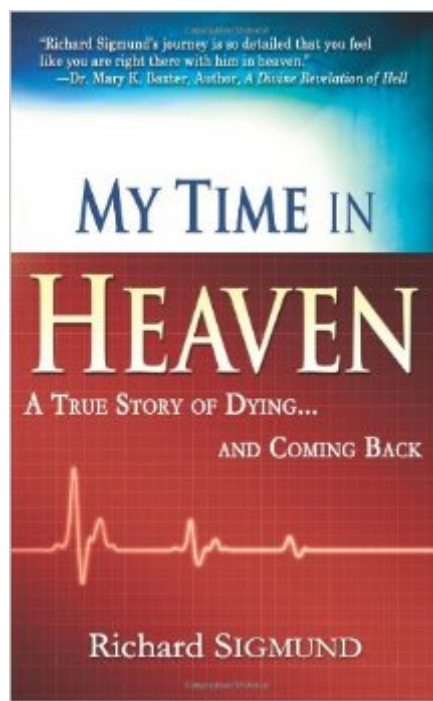

This is by far the best first-hand experience book on Heaven that I've ever read. I've read 90 Minutes in Heaven by Don Piper which was very good. However, Mr. Sigmund was in heaven for 8

hours and explains his experiences with such vivid recall that the two books can hardly be compared except to say that Mr. Piper's book was an appetizer and Mr. Sigmund's book was a 5-course meal. This book is not to be missed!!

In short, Mr. Sigmund does an excellent job of describing the undescribable. He was given a heavenly tour, and the book is a real page turner from start to finish.
